## 16° ROSSO VINO D'ITALIA



Appellation:	Rosso Vino d'Italia
Production area:	Vineyards of the Italian Peninsula
Climate:	Italy has a predominantly Mediterranean climate with mild, sometimes rainy winters and sunny, hot, and usually dry summers.
Harvest:	September/October
Bottle size:	750 ml
Serving temp.:	12/14 °C
Alcohol:	16% vol

-  Intense red in colour.
-  A rich bouquet of raspberries and plum in addition to pleasant chocolate notes.
-  Well-rounded, rich and juicy, with a perfect balance between soft tannins and acidity.
-  Perfect with pasta dishes, roasted lamb and mature cheeses.

**VINIFICATION:** After a soft pressing and destemming, fermentation takes place at a controlled temperature for about 20 days with frequent pump overs. After the malolactic fermentation, the wine rests in stainless steel for a few months before bottling.
